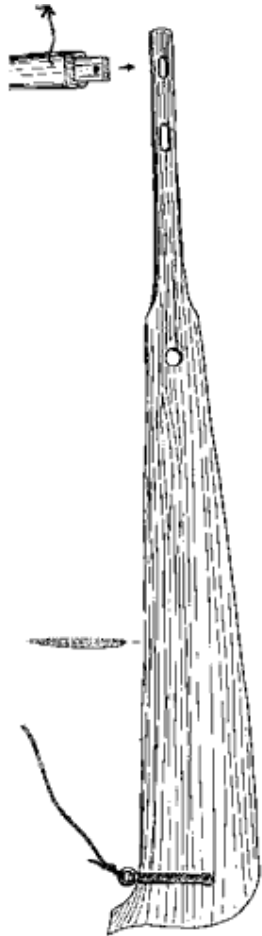
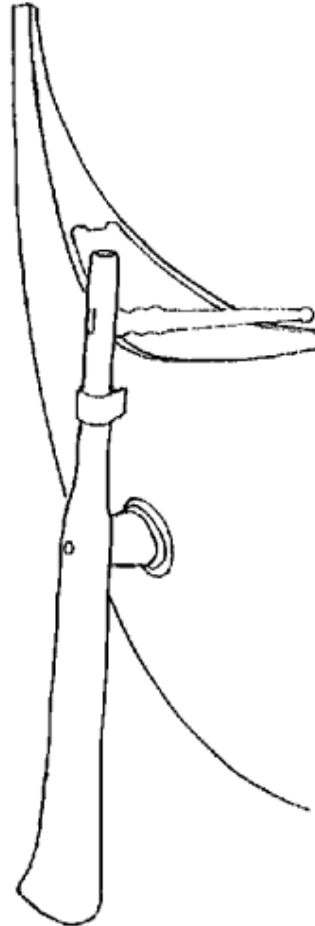


Viking Ship Construction - Steering
